

GPA Calculation Chart

Letter Grade	Numerical Grade	Points	AP/DE Weighted Points
A+	100-97	4	5
A	96-94	4	5
A-	93-90	3.7	4.7
B+	89-87	3.3	4.3

To calculate a cumulative GPA, add points and/or weighted points of core classes (English, Math, Science, Social Studies/History) as well as foreign languages and Bible. **One** full credit in 9-12 may be used in each of the following: PE, Health, Career Prep. Divide this sum by the number of qualifying classes.

For example, a student earned the following scores and points in these classes in one academic year:

English	97	4
Algebra 1	84	3
World Hy	92	3.7
Physical Sc	89	3.3
Career Prep	100	4
PE	100	4
Keyboarding	98	NA

$$4 + 3 + 3.7 + 3.3 + 4 + 4 = 22$$

$$22/6 = 3.67$$

For a cumulative 9-12 GPA, do this for all four years and divide by the number of qualifying classes.
