Department Achievement Awards

Academic Honor Cord is based on classes in 9th grade through the first semester of 12th grade. Students who qualify for honor cords will receive a personal email shortly after first semester grades for senior year are reported to Harvest Homeschool on January 15. **Cord distinctions will not be evaluated by this office after January 15.**

Double Gold cord- 3.7 or higher cumulative GPA for grades 9-12

Double Silver cord- 3.3 to 3.6 cumulative GPA for grades 9-12

Bible Honor cord (double white) is based on successful completion and a cumulative GPA of 3.7 in 4 Bible courses in grades 9-12. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Daily devotion and/or Bible reading does not qualify.

English Honor cord (navy blue) is based on successful completion and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 in at least 2 DE English courses at a qualifying college or university or 3.7 in 4 English courses in grades 9-12.

Math Honor cord (purple is based on successful completion and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 in at least 2 DE Math courses at a qualifying college or university or 3.7 in 4 Math courses in grades 9-12.

Science Honor cord (black) is based on successful completion and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 in at least 2 DE Science courses at a qualifying college or university or 3.7 in 4 Science courses in grades 9-12.

Social Science/History cord (white) is based on successful completion and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 in at least 2 DE History courses at a qualifying college or university or 3.7 in 4 History courses in grades 9-12.

Agricultural Education cord (green) is based on successful completion and a cumulative GPA of 3.7 in at least 2 agricultural classes. Membership in 4-H or similar organization is required. Documentation of membership and attendance at no fewer than three 4-H or similar organization events must be on file by January 15. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Elective form may be used for documentation.

Business/Marketing/Information Technology cord (turquoise) is based on successful completion and a cumulative GPA of 3.7 in at least 2 business/marketing/information technology classes. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Elective form may be used for documentation.

Art/Dance/Drama cord (gold) is based on successful completion and/or cumulative GPA of 3.7 in at least 2 years/classes in art/dance/drama. Documentation from art/dance/drama instructor or online class must be on file by January 15. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Elective form may be used for documentation.

Family and Consumer Science cord (light blue) is based on successful completion and cumulative GPA of 3.7 in at least 2 classes in the Family and Consumer Sciences. For example, foods, child development, and childcare classes. Documentation from instructor or online class must be on file by January 15. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Elective form may be used for documentation.

Health Science cord (royal blue) is based on successful completion and cumulative GPA of 3.7 in at least 2 Health Science classes. For example, Medical Anatomy, Physiology, Exercise Science, and Sports Medicine. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Elective form may be used for documentation.

Music/Band/Choir cord (navy and gold intertwined) is based on successful completion and/or cumulative GPA 3.7 in at least 2 years/classes in music/band/choir groups/classes. Documentation from music/band/choir instructor or online class must be on file by January 15. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Elective form may be used for documentation.

World Languages cord (red) is based on successful completion and cumulative GPA of 3.7 in at least 2 foreign language classes. Sign language is an acceptable language class. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Elective form may be used for documentation.

Trade and Technical cord (red, white, and blue intertwined) is based on successful completion and cumulative GPA of 3.7 in at least 2 Trade or Technical classes. For example, auto tech, woodshop, carpentry, commercial art, welding. Documentation from Trade or Technical instructor/owner or online class must be on file by January 15. Must provide the program name used to complete these courses. Elective form may be used for documentation.
